NAWB is guided by a 28-member Board of Directors, comprised primarily of Workforce Board chairs and past chairs that provide the strategic leadership and oversight of federal workforce investments and the One-Stop Career Center system at the local level. Founded in 1979, NAWB membership consists of 505 local boards and 39 governor-appointed state workforce investment boards representing approximately 15,000 volunteers from business and other sectors.
- **National Association of Counties** – The National Association of Counties (NACo) is a full-service organization that provides legislative, research, technical and public affairs assistance to county governments. Created in 1935, NACo continues to ensure that the nation’s 3,066 counties are heard and understood in The White House and Congress.
